#### Ho'ōla Lāhui – “Nā ‘Ono o ka ‘Āina”

Watch this video documentary by Nā maka o ka ‘Āina titled, Nā ‘Ono o ka ‘Āina. Uncle Jerry Konanui shares his knowledge and expertise of growing kalo. He calls out many different varieties he is aware of that adapt to some of the harshest climates and encourages folks to look to the wisdom of our kūpuna and learn from this wisdom. Today the lehua variety dominates the commercial industry and does not necessarily adapt well to harsh living conditions. He talks about the many other varieties that are available. He also shares his stance on genetic engineering of kalo. The mele, Nā ‘Ono o ka ‘Āina accompanies this documentary and talks about the different varieties and what they are known and favored for by our kūpuna.

Aloha ‘Āina – “Ho‘oulu Lāhui Aloha-To Raise a Beloved Nation: Ep – 161  
#159 Hō‘ailona and the Coming of the Seals”

Kēhaulani Watson moderates a discussion with four kupa or native born of Moloka‘i who share their thoughts regarding the Hawaiian monk seal. They talk about the recent slaying of a Hawaiian monk seal and it’s cultural implications. Husband and wife, Walter and Loretta Ritte, Kahu David Ka‘upu, and Moloka‘i musician, Lono join Kēhau to discuss the issue. Each of these individuals share their perspectives how the small community of Moloka‘i embraced Hō‘ailona, a seal they named and befriended in Kaunakakai.
