## GIRLS: GRADES 9-12

1. It is not necessary for your daughter to have all new clothes--be sure to use clothes you have on hand which are in good condition and will meet the needs indicated below. Keep in mind that the wardrobe will be increased as the year progresses.
2. All items should be clearly marked--preferably with a marker or sew-on labels.

5. P. E. Uniforms must be purchased at The Kamehameha Schools Store. The Kamehameha Schools Store is located on the second floor of 'Akahi.
