Far away from here in a forest of Tasmania, there lived a small and lonely tasmanian devil.



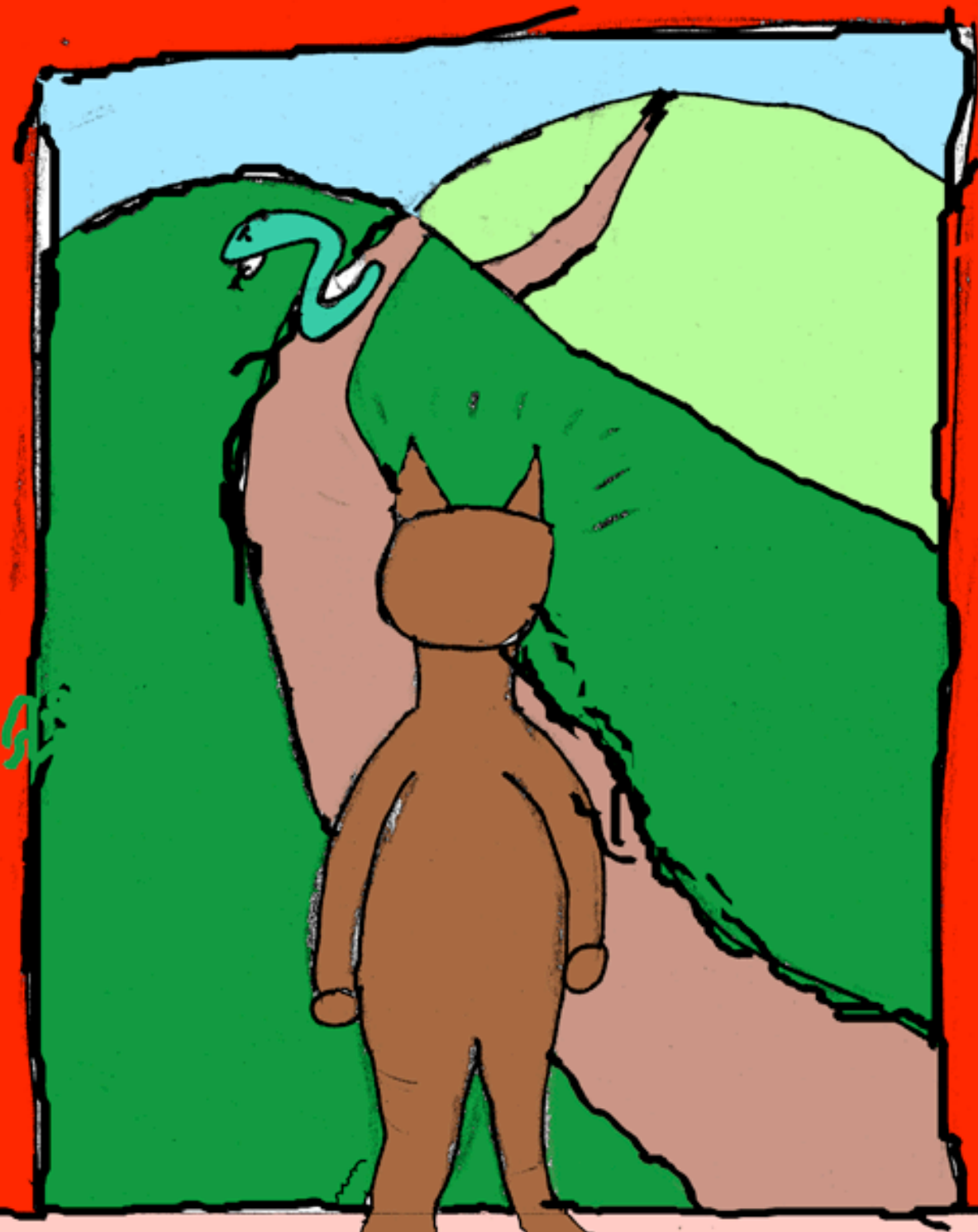
He was not as big or as strong as all the other animals. They did not play with him. Instead, they teased him of how small he was.
