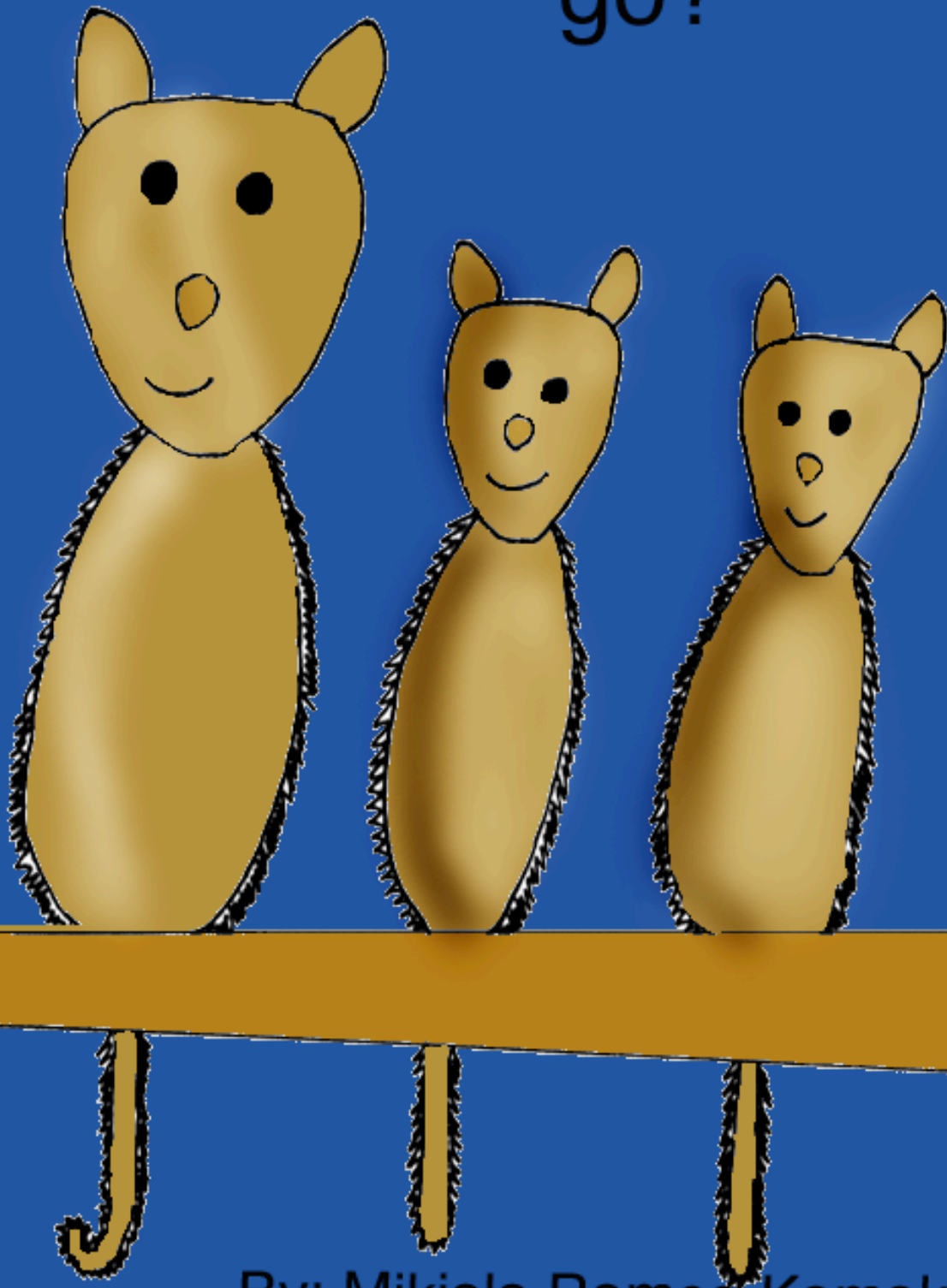
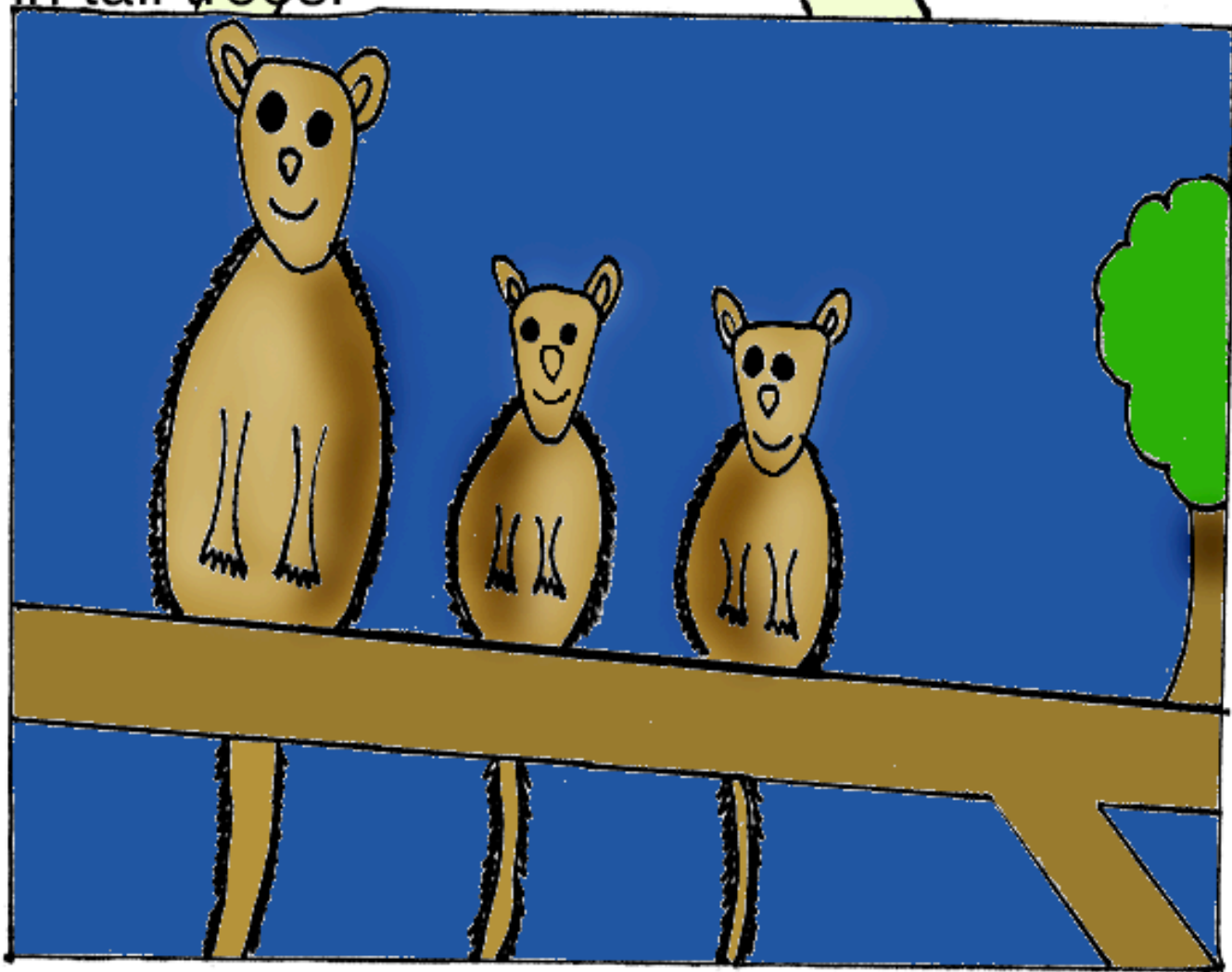


Where did Kinka and Jou
go?

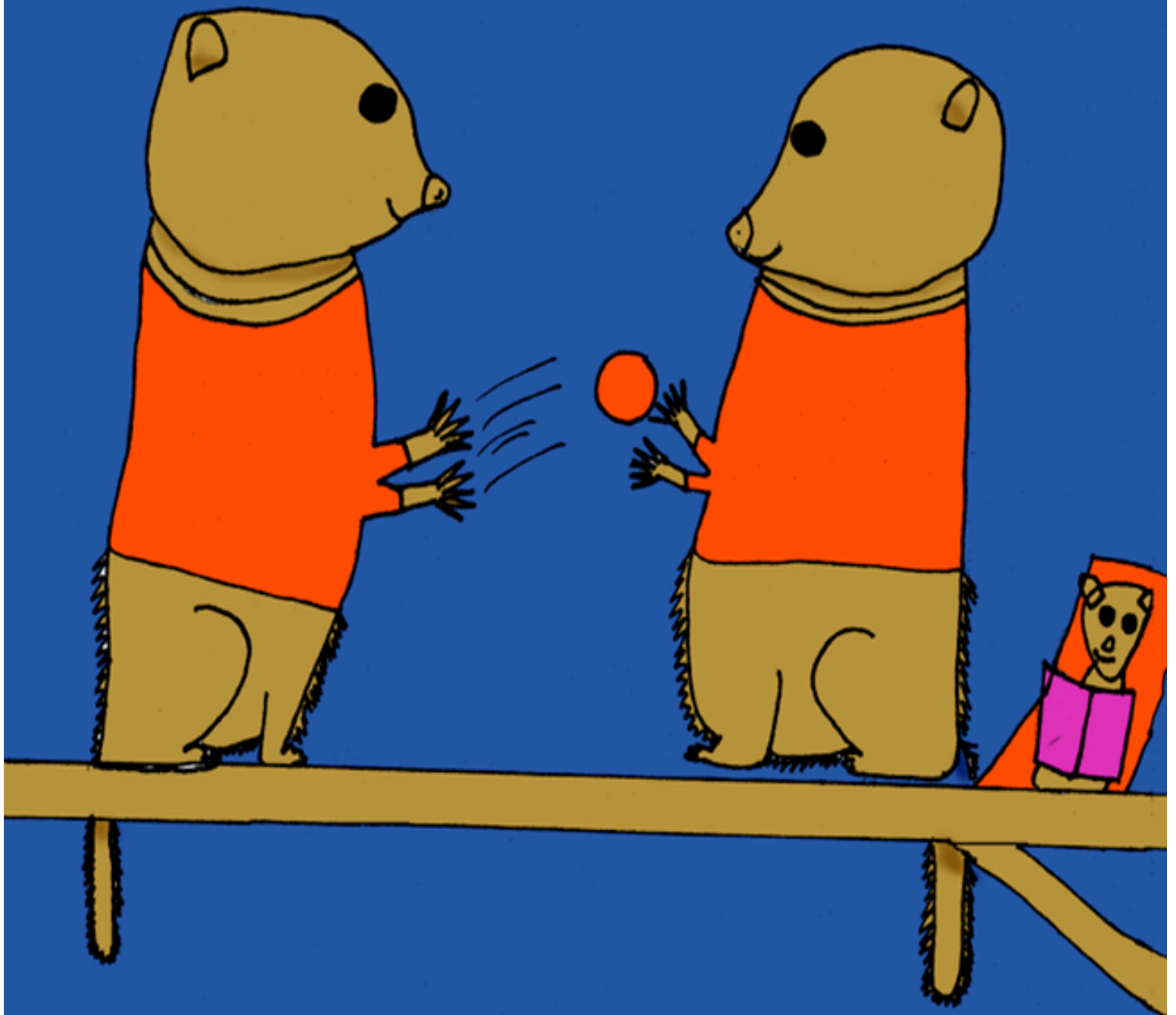

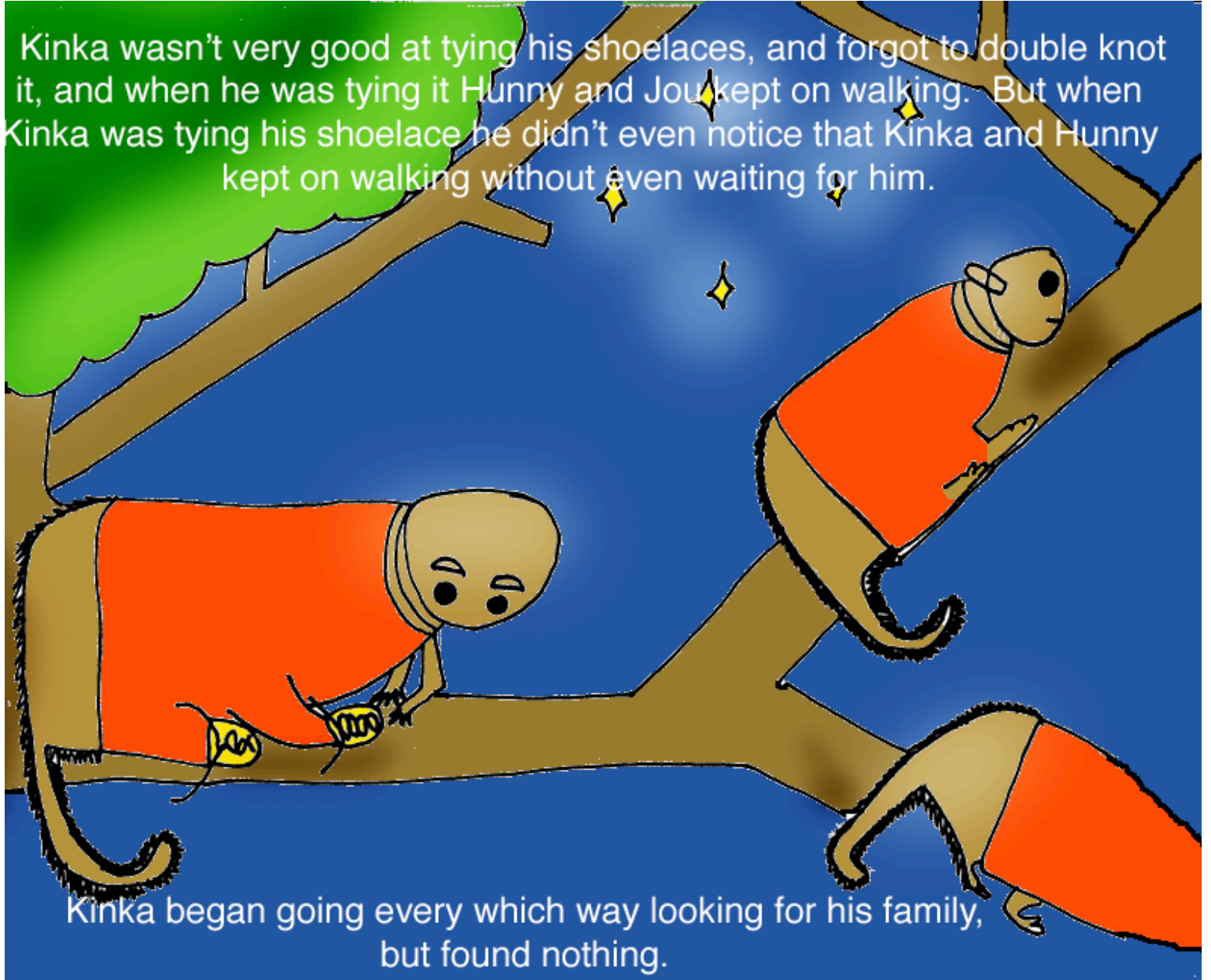

Kinka, Jou, and Hunny are only active at night so they search for honey in a beehive or nectar from a flower.

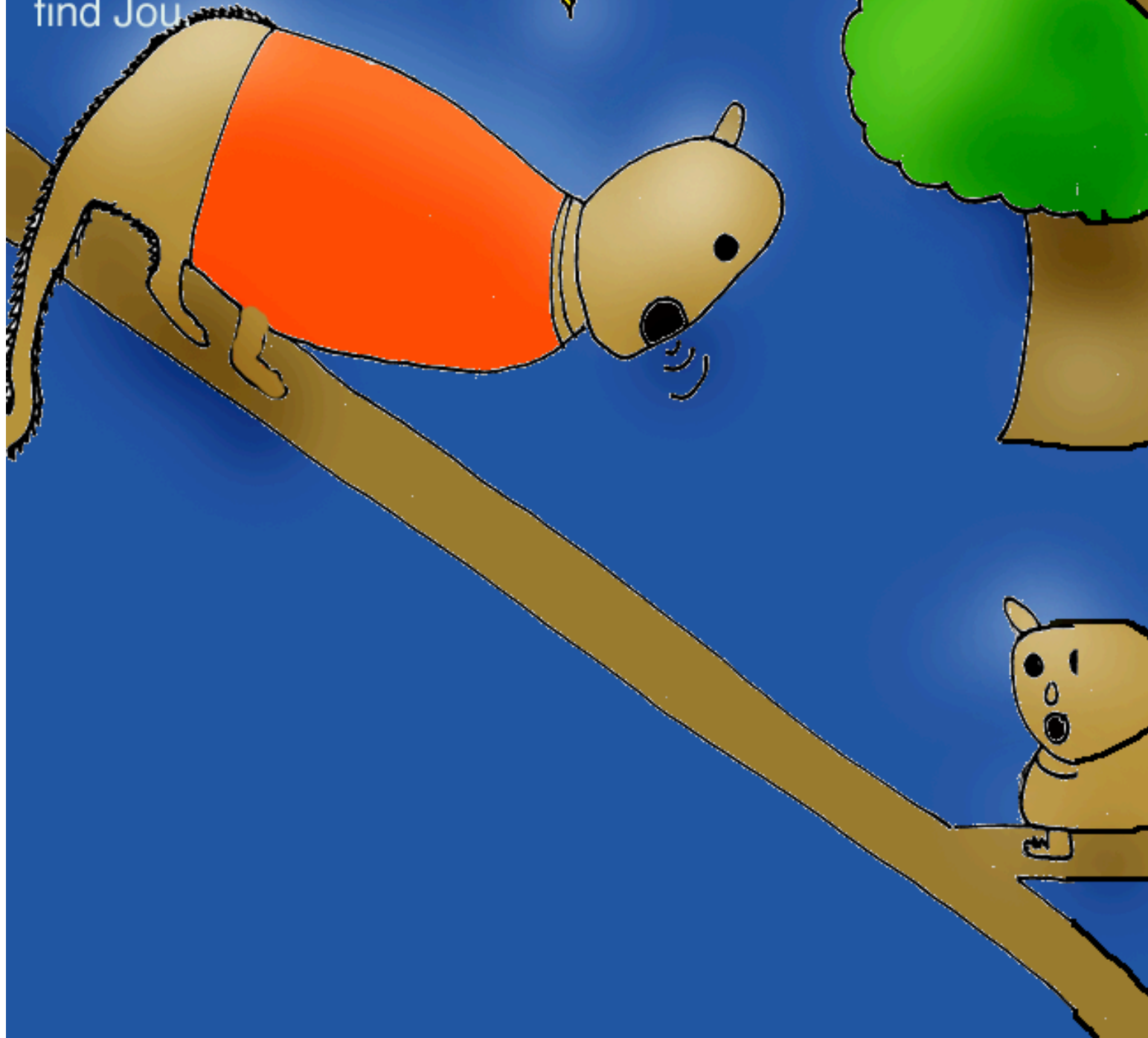

Kinka began going every which way looking for his family, but found nothing.

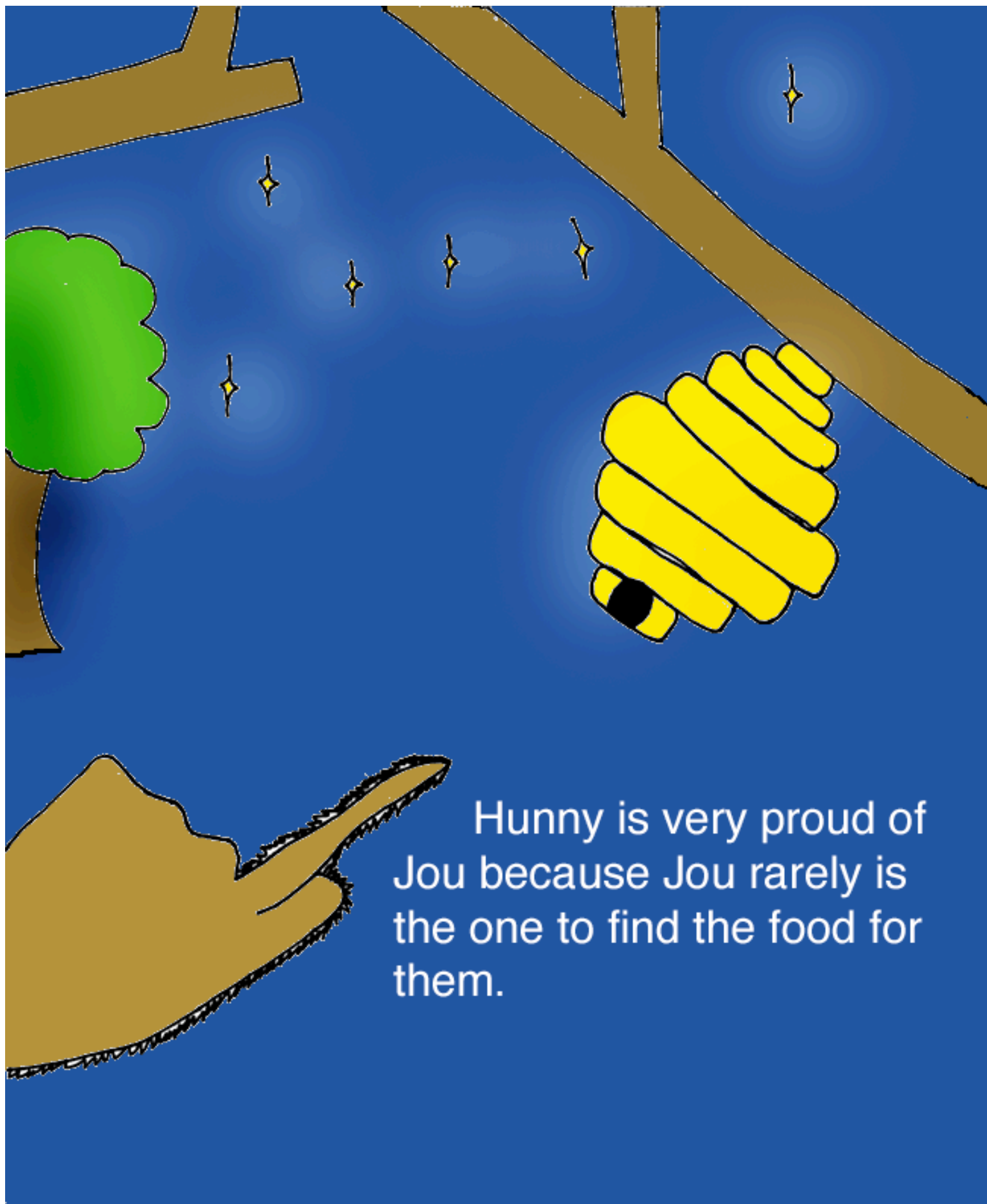
