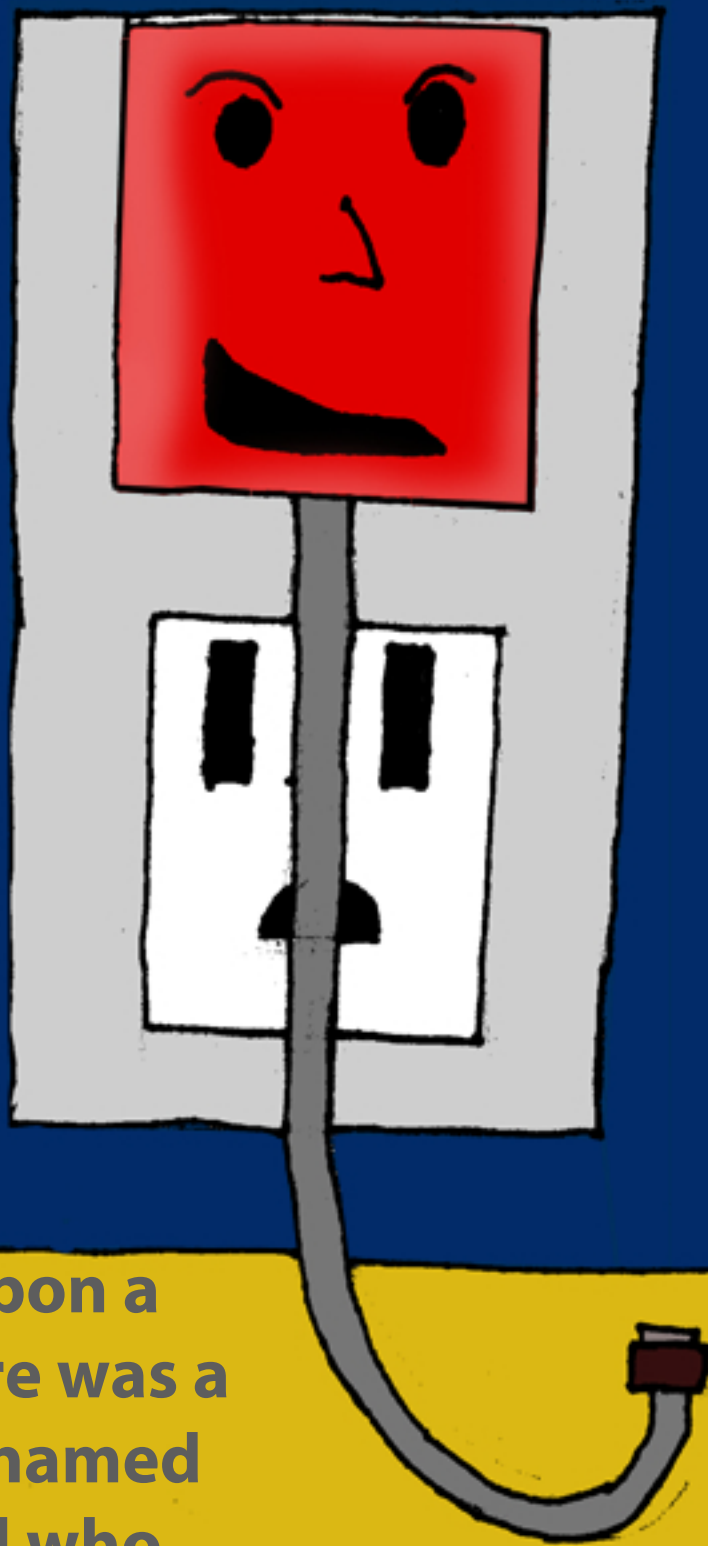

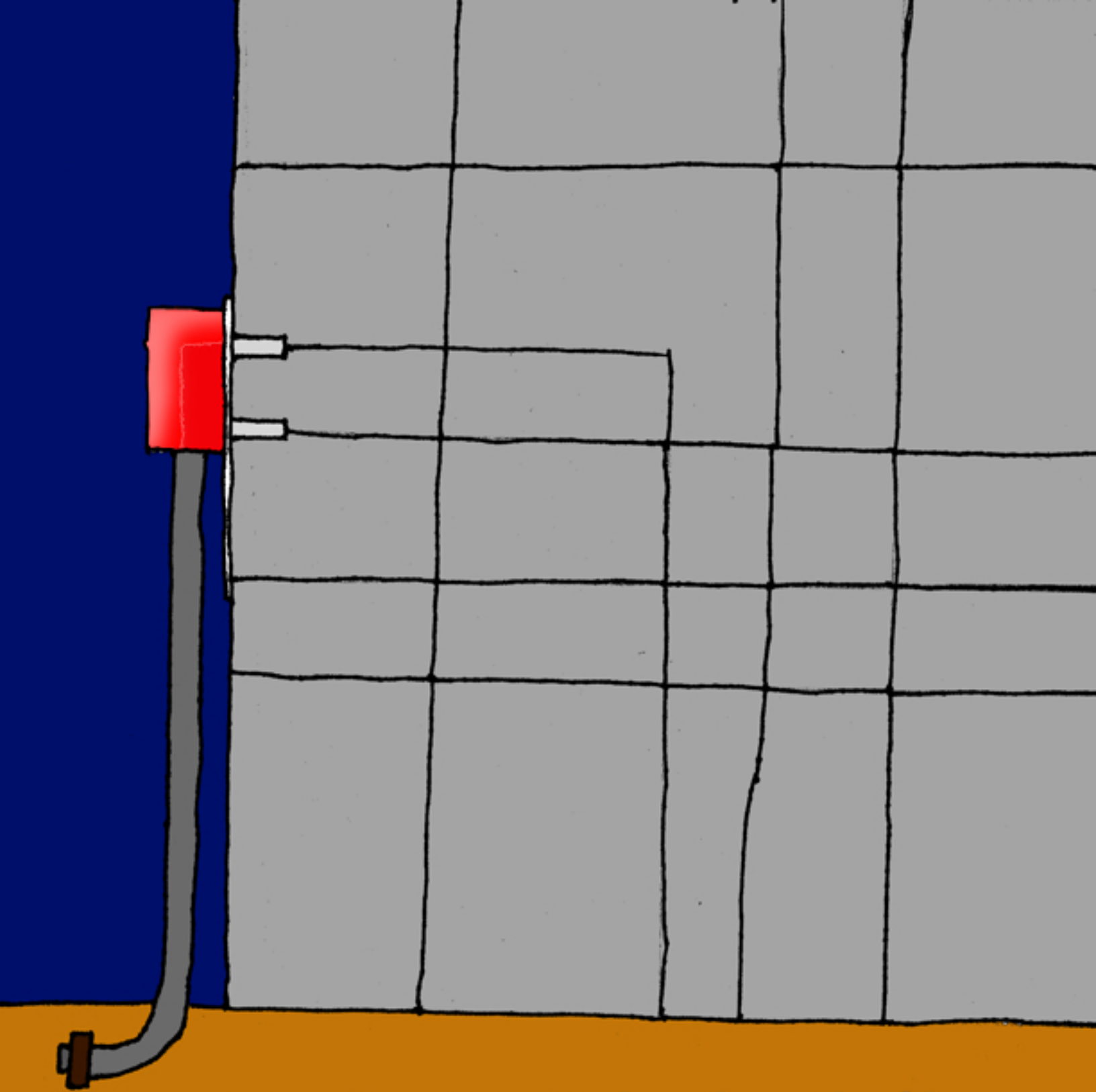
The Marvelous

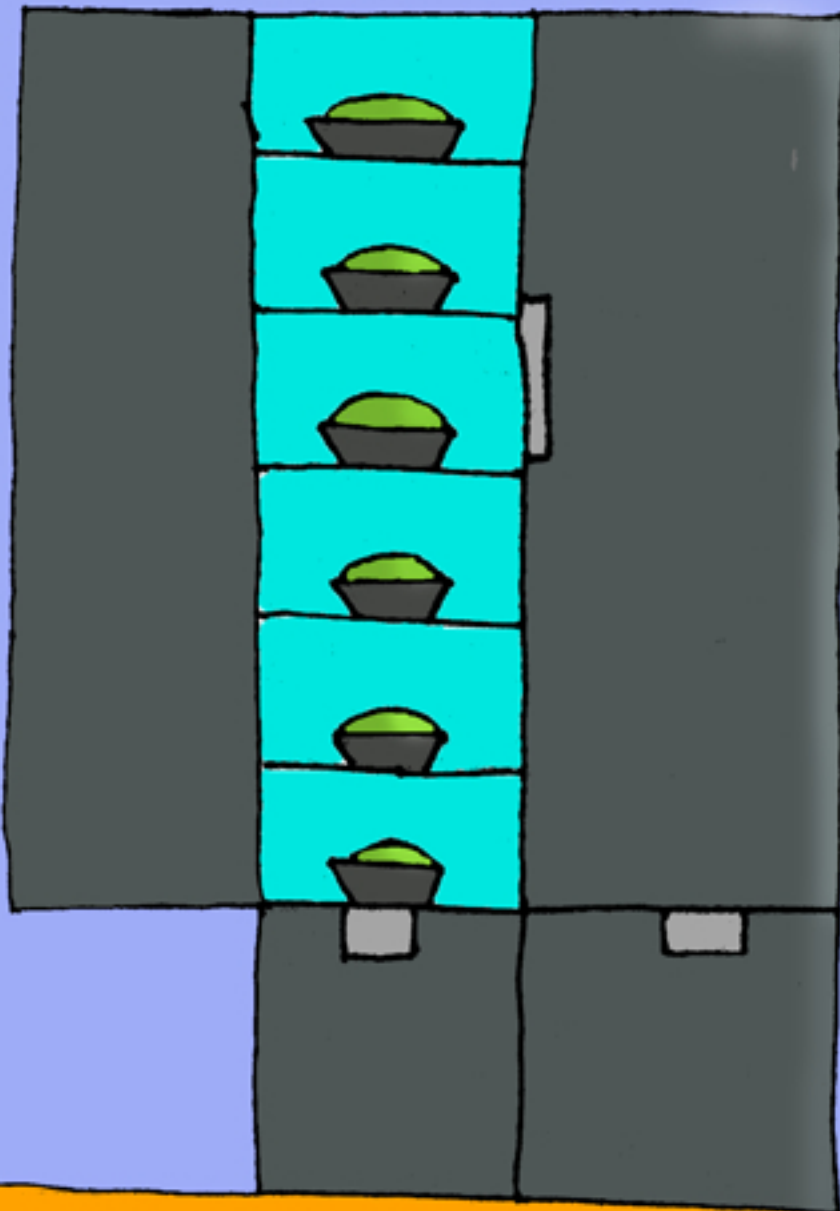


Once upon a time, there was a charger named Michael who stayed in the wall all day and all night.

He sucked out electricity and he didn't want to burn out.

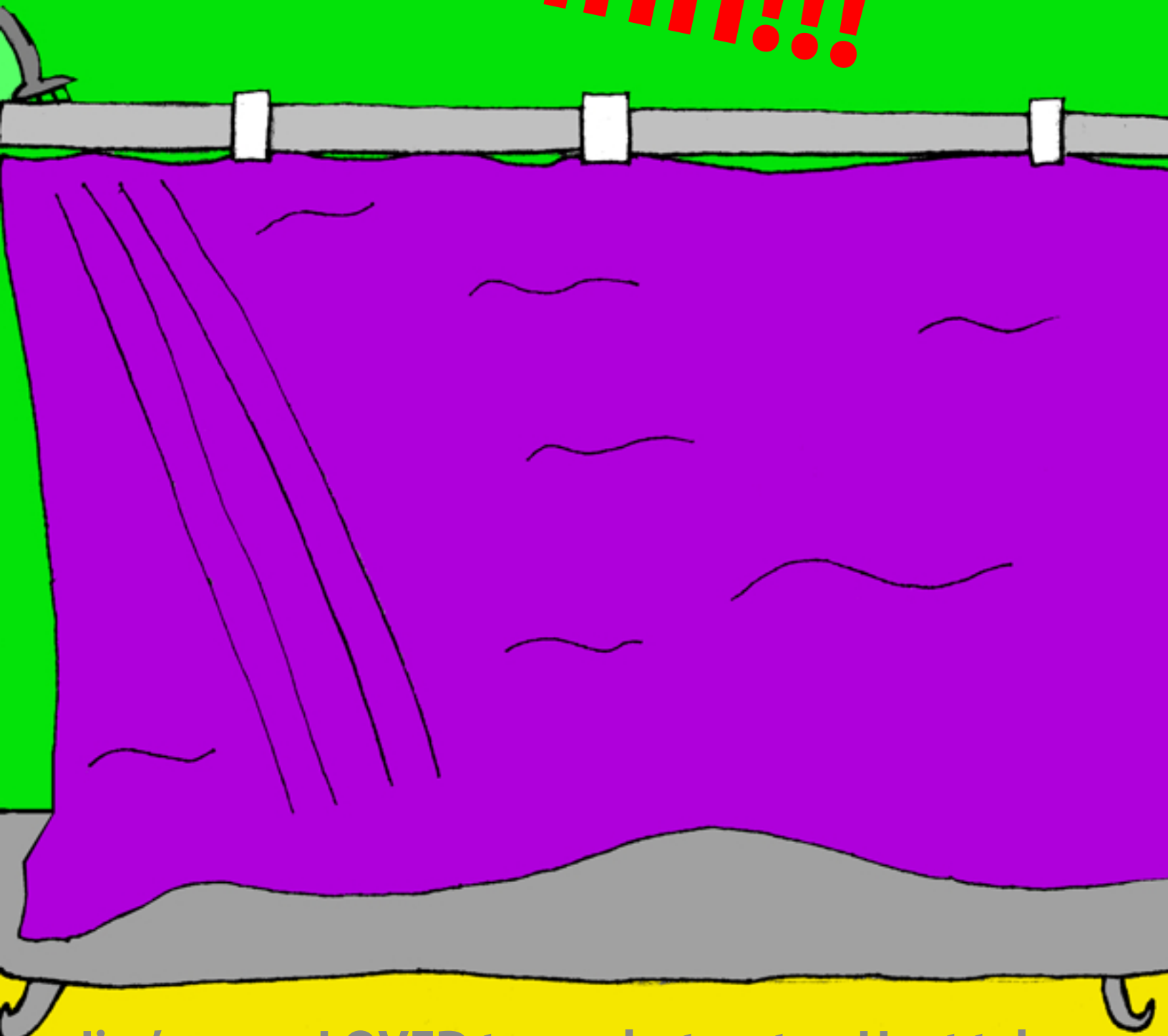

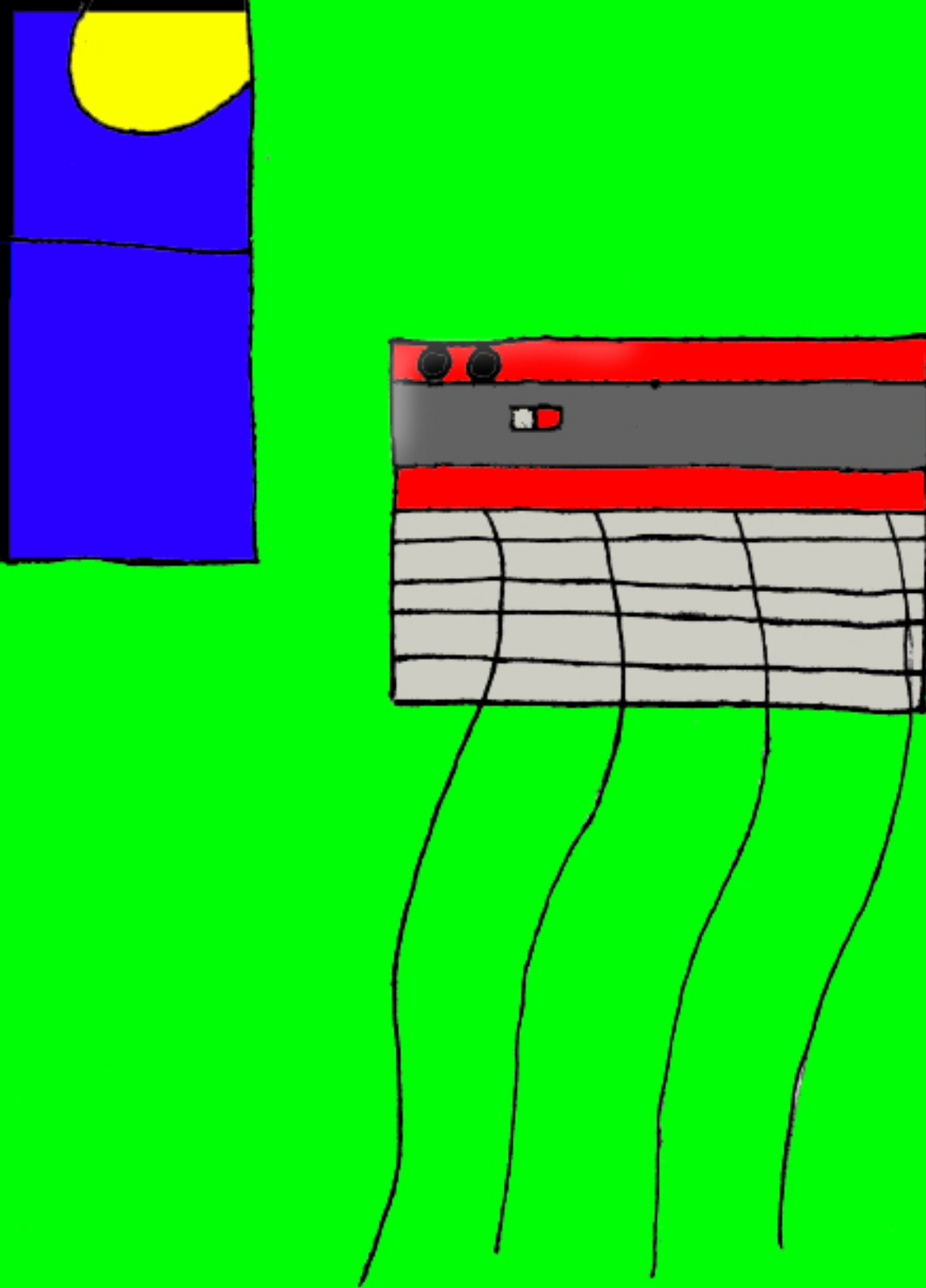
