Kalepa Baybayan a true master of celestial navigation will guide us through different voyaging activities, including a visit to the planetarium to see the star lines that guide the navigators. We will explore the voyaging section of the museum and learn about the plants that were used by these ancient navigators. We will be planting one of our own as a makana to the 'Imiloa Center. When our Saturday morning exploration is done, keiki accompanied by parents may continue exploring the museum and planetarium during the afternoon.
