23 & 24, the guidelines are:*

Boys:

- Aloha attire is island wear, the same as May Day attire
- Pants & shorts must be tailored (tailored jeans are acceptable)
- Collared aloha shirt (if shirt is tucked in, a belt must be worn)
- Athletic shoes with socks

Girls:

- Aloha attire is island wear, the same as May Day attire
- Pants & shorts must be tailored (tailored jeans are acceptable)
- No spaghetti straps or halter tops (straps must be two inches or more wide)
- No tight-fitting dresses
- Shorts or skirt length must not be shorter than 2 inches above the knee while standing
- Sandals or shoes are permitted & heels should not exceed 1 1/2 inches. Sandals must have a back strap. Please bring athletic shoes if you have P.E. during those days.
