'Elua hopuna o 'akahi nō a. Inā he i'oa pani (pronoun) ka piko (subject) he kau 'ia ma mua o ka a.

'Akahi nō lāua a noi puna hou. (They just now asked for a new spoon.)

'Akahi nō mākou a ho'omaika'i i ka mea'ai.
(We just blessed the food.)

'Akahi nō 'o ia a kī i ke kao. (He finally shot the goat.)

'Akahi nō māua a ho'olauna 'ia.
(We have never been introduced before.)

Inā 'a'ole ka piko he i'oa pani, he kau 'ia ka piko ma hope aku.

E unuhi i kēia mau hopuna me 'akahi nō a.

1. I just now pressed the button.
2. The wave finally broke.
3. They just now left Līhu'e.
4. The light just now went on.
5. My mangos were never stolen before(now).
6. You just heard him.
7. E hana i hopuna me 'akahi nō a me ka i'oa pani.
8. E hana i hopuna me 'akahi nō a akā mai ho'okomo i ka i'oa pani i loko.

Nā 'Ōlelo Ho'ākāka

1. E ho'ohālikelike i kēia mau 'ōlelo:

- a) 'Akahi nō au a 'ike iā Keola.
I just saw Keola. (He was here a minute ago.)
- e) 'O Keola wale nō ka mea a'u i 'ike ai.
I just saw Keola. (and nobody else.)
- i) Ua 'ike wale nō au iā Keola.
I just saw Keola. (I didn't get to talk to him or anything.)

'Oiai (although) ho'okahi nō 'ōlelo Haole, 'ekolu mana'o, a he mau mana'o i loa'a nā 'ōlelo 'oko'a ma ka 'ōlelo Hawai'i.

2. He 'ōlelo piha 'ole ka 'ōlelo Mai i koloaka. (Bring me a soda), I poi na'u (I want poi), a pēlā aku. Kohu mea (It seems as if) ua hā'ule ka 'ōlelo E lawe mai 'oe, Makemake au, a E hā'awi ma kēia mau hopuna.

(E lawe mai 'oe) i lei no kēia keiki. Bring a lei for this boy.

3. Ua hiki ke wehe 'ia (removed) ka 'ōlelo nō ma 'akahi no a akā he mea ma'amau ke komo 'ana o nō. Ua hiki ho'i ke komo nā 'ōlelo ho'i, paha, a pēlā aku ma hope o 'akahi.

'Akahi a pau ke kula. (School has just ended.)

'Akahi ho'i a 'ike ku'u maka i ka nani o Waiākea.
(My eyes have finally seen the beauty of Waiākea.)
