RE: Skills covered this week and other news



Math: Students began work in chapter 2, "Represent and Interpret Data." Students learned about different ways to organize and read data. We learned about tally tables, frequency tables, picture graphs, and horizontal and vertical bar graphs. Students learned to read the information from the graphs as well as how to make the different graphs. The challenge for most of the keiki has been the problem solving questions. We will continue to work on this!

Reading: Students should be reading a chapter book of choice.

Students are reading Stink and the Incredible, Super
Galactic Jawbreaker by Megan MacDonald. We are learning about idioms, as this book has a lot of them ©. Students learned about literal and non-literal language, covering the third grade standard: RL.3.4 I can determine the meaning of words and phrases as they are used in a text, distinguishing literal from nonliteral language.

Writing: Students will be learning about writing letters, and writing one just like Stink did in the above story.

Students will be creating an idiom comic like Stink did in the book, <u>Stink and the Incredible, Super-Galactic Jawbreaker</u>. Ask your child which idiom he/she chose to create a comic strip for.
