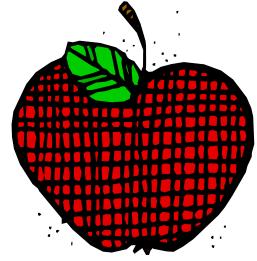

RE: Skills covered this week and other news

Math: Students took a chapter 2 end-of-chapter-test, "Represent and Interpret Data." We will begin chapter 3, "Understand Multiplication," next week.

Reading: *Students should be reading a chapter book of choice.* The target reading comprehension strategy we worked on was "asking questions." As we read, we ask questions to help us understand what we are reading.

Students finished the book, *Stink and the Incredible, Super-Galactic Jawbreaker* by Megan MacDonald. The students loved the characters, and had fun learning about idioms and literal/non-literal language.

Writing: Students are completing their own comic strip, illustrating the meaning of an idiom of choice.
