Math: Students are working in Chapter 3, "Understand Multiplication." The following learning objectives were worked on: I can...

- Model and skip count objects in equal groups to find how many there are
- Write an addition sentence and a multiplication sentence for a model
- Model and skip count on a number line to find how many there are
- Solve one- and two-step problems by using the strategy draw a diagram
- Use arrays to model multiplication and find factors
- Use the Commutative Property of Multiplication to find products
  Reading: Students are reading a chapter book of choice. We will be
  doing AR as soon as I get the username and password for everyone. I will
  keep you posted, as everyone will have a goal for their independent reading.

Students have done work to demonstrate various reading strategies. RL.3.10: I can read and comprehend stories appropriate for a third grader. They learned about making connections. Making connections deepens our understanding and helps us bring meaning to the text. RL.3.1: I can ask and answer questions to demonstrate I understand what I read. We read various stories and discussed and read questions we had before reading, during reading and after reading. RL.3.3: I can describe characters in a story and explain how their actions affect the order of events. The book, Judy Moody was in a Mood, was an excellent book to discuss character traits! RL.3.4: I can determine the difference between literal and nonliteral language. Stink and the Incredible, Super-Galactic Jawbreaker by Megan MacDonald was perfect for this standard. We are continually working on standard RL.3.10 from above. Students are now working on making inferences as they read. We are practicing using this strategy while reading Stage Fright on a Summer Night by Mary Pope Osborne.

**Writing:** Students are working on a poem about their many names, Koʻu Inoa.
