Kamehameha Schools Maui is delighted to host this momentous ceremony for the Class of 2013 and we rely on all attendees to assist with supporting a safe and memorable occasion for the graduating seniors and the school community. **Please note: EVERY attendee will submit bag(s) at a checkpoint before entering the seating area.**

EXPECTATIONS: Kamehameha Schools is a drug free, alcohol free, smoke free campus.

Items NOT permitted in the gymnasium:

- Coolers, containers of alcohol, alcohol leis.
- Balloons, name sign, banners. Come prepared to leave in car or outside the facility.
- Air horns or similar noise items
- Confetti of any type. A \$750 cleaning charge will be assessed for any debris left behind.

Items NOT permitted in the soccer field/reception area and campus parking lots: Coolers, containers of alcohol and alcohol leis.

COMMENCEMENT TICKETS Students will receive 2 blue RESERVED tickets (blue section fronting the stage) and 13 GENERAL admission tickets. No waiting list or extra ticket distribution. Tickets are distributed upon satisfaction of all senior obligations (fees, return of school equipment, etc.)

ADMISSION by ticket only. A ticket is required for children and infants.

DOORS OPEN at Noon.

OVERFLOW VENUE The program will be projected to the High School Dining Hall and is the recommended location for infants and active young children.

PARKING Cars will be directed to parking areas by Safety/Security staff. Please plan to arrive early and allow for traffic and the time necessary to park and walk to the event. Access assistance shuttle is available for those needing assistance from the designated handicap parking in the stadium

lot.

ACCESS ASSISTANCE (Handicapped) Please display the Handicapped placard to allow the Safety/Security staff to recognize and direct you to the designated parking space. Shuttle will be available for handicapped visitors.

PHOTOGRAPHY Nagamine Photography, Inc. will take a photo of each student receiving their diploma from the High School Principal. About two weeks after the event, Nagamine will mail proofs to families to facilitate orders.

LEI GREETING All graduates will be escorted to the field fronting the gymnasium after the ceremony. The letters of the alphabet will be staged around the field to facilitate the location of graduating seniors.

NON TICKET HOLDERS All individuals not allowed admission into the Graduation site may proceed to the High School Dining Hall which is the overflow facility that will have a direct video feed of the event. Individuals may also wait in the field fronting the gymnasium. All expectations of the event apply to those waiting in the field and non-compliance will not be tolerated. KS Maui reserves the right to deny access to individuals that do not abide by KS Maui expectations.
