

Aloha e Nā`Ohana,

This is a reminder that Wednesday, September 2nd, November 4th, February 26th and April 21st are K-12 early release days. Dismissal is as follows:

12:20 p.m.: K-2 car pick up students and their siblings in grades 3-6

12:30 p.m.: All other students in grades K-6.

Please note that all students will be served lunch prior to dismissal.

The following is a schedule for pick up and shuttles to the terminal and rural areas:

CAR PICK UP

K-2 Car Pick Up Dismissed at 12:20 p.m.

(If you have students in K-2 and siblings in upper grades, upper grade students will be picked up with K-2 at the Nahi`ena`ena Island Car Pick up)

12:20-12:35 p.m.: Grades K-2: Nahi`ena`ena Island Car Pick up (siblings in grades 3-6 should go to the Nahi`ena`ena Island Car Pick up at 12:20 p.m.) All cars exiting from this car pick up area will not be allowed to exit down Bishop Drive through Makanani Gate. Cars must exit through the main gate or Puna Gates only. Officers will have the traffic flow outlined for you and be available to assist. Please abide by their instructions.

12:35-12:55 p.m.: Grades 3-6: Kamāmalu Lower Car Pick up

All cars utilizing this pick up area are to enter from the Makanani Gate, and form the waiting line back down Bishop Drive to the Makanani Gate entrance. Officers will have the traffic flow outlined for you and be available to assist. Please abide by their instructions

Please do not enter the car pick up area early. This creates a traffic jam and if other cars behind you have been loaded, you will be asked to move to the back of the line to expedite the process. All are asked to respect the instructions of KES staff when asked to do so.

TERMINAL SHUTTLE

12:35 p.m.: Terminal Shuttle (Students not picked up by 1:00 p.m. will be taken to Kama`āina Kids.)

KS BUS SERVICE

12:45 p.m. Early Bus Shuttles: (Kaneohe A, Waimanalo A, Pearl City/Aiea, Mililani A; Waianae A)

12:55 p.m. Late Bus Shuttles: (all other rural service areas)

NO SWIM SHUTTLE

Swim Club will begin at 3:00 p.m. but students are NOT ALLOWED to stay on campus between dismissal and swim club practice. You will need to make arrangements for their transportation home and then return to campus for Swim Club or enroll in Kama`āina Kids (limited space available).

Early bus shuttles will leave directly from elementary. Please be at your child's bus pick up location no later than **30** minutes after the KES departure time. Late buses will proceed to middle school and high school for student pick up before leaving campus. Please be at your child's bus pick up location no later than **60** minutes after the KES departure time. Please keep in mind that traffic at this time of day is different and these are approximations of travel times.

Kama`āina Kids will again provide services to those students who are currently enrolled on a regular basis. They will also accept applications for the day (though space is limited). Please contact them at 842-8042 for details.
