- Use Google Photos to create collaborative (shared) albums to which others can contribute

Google Photos Workflow

- WASC KHS Climate and Community Photo Album created
- Log in with KS Google account
- Upload your photo
- Add photo to shared album
- Copy/paste or type your caption for the photo by **APR 15**
