Headroom (Rule of Thirds)	10 Headroom is in the top third of the Rule of Thirds	5 Headroom is less than 10% above or below the Rule of thirds line	2 Headroom is more than 10% below or above the Rule of Thirds line
Framing & Composition (Rule of Thirds, Talk Space)	10 Talent is framed off to one of the third lines so there is proper talk space in front of the face	5 Talent is right in the center	2 Talent is talking in the wrong direction with no talk space
Juxtaposition	10 Backgrounds are clear of distracting elements	-----	2 Distracting elements in background “grow out” of talents head/body
