**Comma (numbers) [1], Parentheses [2], Hyphen (single-thought adjectives) [3], Verb (tense) [1]**

Light moved at such an out of this world rate 186000 miles per second that it doesn't seem to move at all.

**Rules:**

**Hyphen** – joins two or more words to form a single-thought adjective before a noun

**Examples:** heat-and-serve meals; microwave-safe cookware

**Verb tenses:**

Present:	I write.	She hides.
Past:	Earlier I wrote.	Earlier she hid.
Past Participle:	I have written.	She has hidden.
