<p>Student Commencement Attire. Report at 7:30 am, dressed</p>	<p>Girls – Uniform white kukui mu`u mu`u in either the tulip sleeve style or the Bette style, plain white slips and undergarments, white shoes or <u>sandals with back strap and heels no higher than 1 inch.</u> Boys – Uniform white kukui print dress shirt with standard collar and white buttons, long white pants, plain white undergarments, white dress shoes, white socks. Note: white pants and white shoes can be rented from formal rental stores</p>
<p>Admission</p>	<p>Ka`ulaheanuiokamoku doors open at 8:00 am. Admission by ticket only.</p>
<p>Parking</p>	<p>Cars will be directed to parking areas by Safety/Security Staff. Please plan to arrive early and allow for traffic and the time necessary to park and walk to the event.
