Welcome to the Maui Volleyball Invitational Tournament, the newest premier pre-season high school girls volleyball tournament in the State of Hawaii. We welcome teams from O'ahu, California, Arizona, Molokai, Lana'i, and Maui. We are excited for you to be participating in our tournament and are looking forward to great matches, great teams, and a great time.

Location

The tournament is located on the campus of Kamehameha Schools Maui in the small upcountry area of Pukalani, Maui. Pool play and tournament play will be at our Middle School and High School campus gyms. The campus will be open for spectators and teams at 2:00pm on August 16th & 17th. Please be respectful at this time of day, as school and classes are still in session on both Thursday and Friday. Directions and maps are provided for your convenience.

Format

Currently we are at 17 teams with several local schools finalizing their entry to get us to 18 teams and possibly 20 teams. The final pool play schedule will be out on Aug. 10, 2012. If we do have 20 teams, 1 pool of 4 teams, will be at Seabury Hall, Friday night only, with all other pools at Kamehameha Maui.

with a minimum 2-point advantage or 27 point scoring cap. A point will be scored on each rally. If the receiving team wins a rally, they score a point and gain the serve. Each

team in the two 3 team pools will play one crossover match..

For any ties, head to head will be used first, then point diff.

Advancement: Teams 1 and 2 from each pool will advance to the High School pools on Friday.

Teams 3 and 4 from each pool will advance to the Middle School pools on Friday.

Day 2

Middle School: Two Pools of 4 teams. Each set will be won by the team that first scores 25 points with a

minimum 2-point advantage or 27 point scoring cap. A point will be scored on each

rally. If the receiving team wins a rally, they score a point and gain the serve.

For any ties, head to head will be used first, then point diff.

Advancement: Teams 1 and 2 from each pool will advance to Ho'oikaika Division on Saturday.
