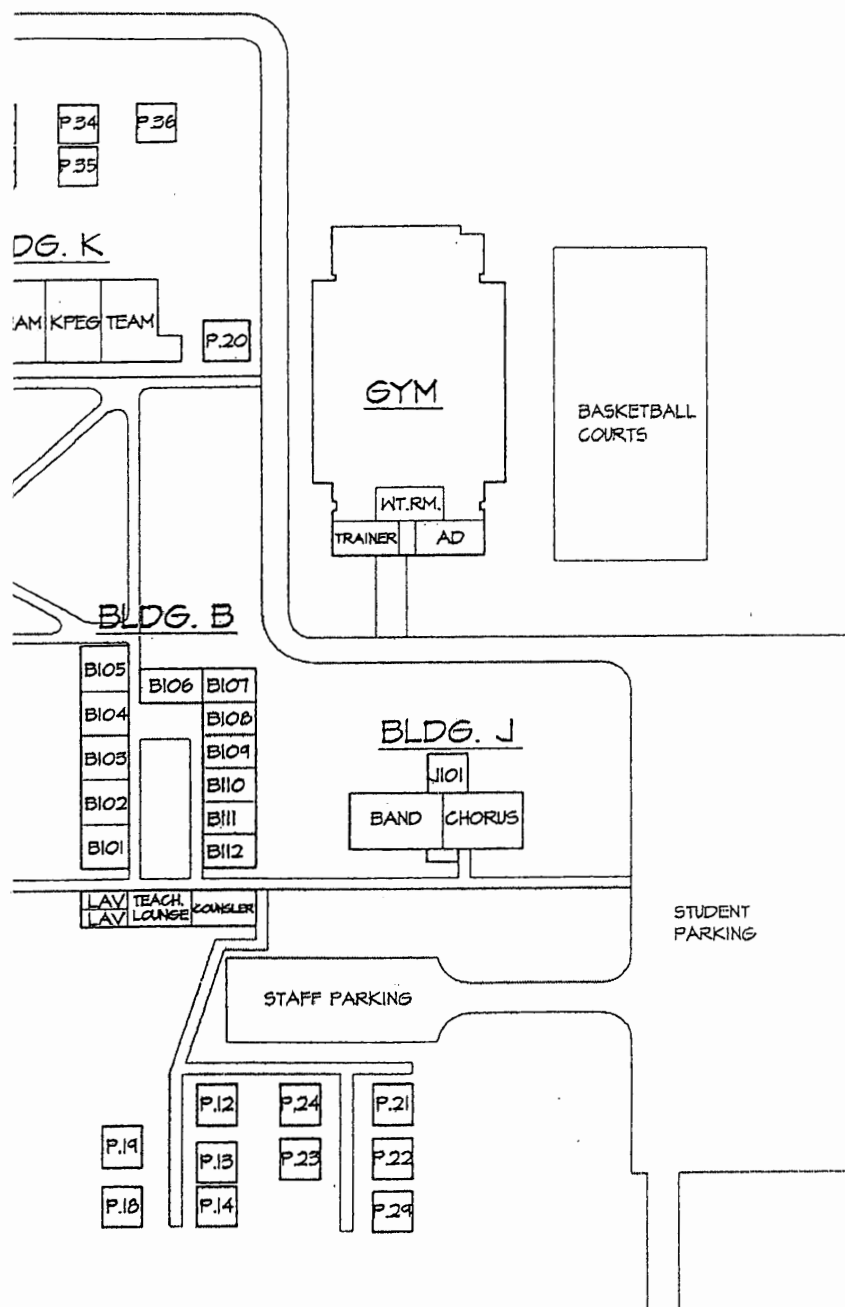


MAUI HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS MAP

1. **NCAA- The Student Athlete** (room B104)

2. **Choosing a College For You** (room B106)
