HOW TO APPLY

To be considered for the COP 2015 program, applicants must complete steps 1 & 2 below. All supporting documents must be received by COP no later than 4:00 p.m. on December 5, 2014. Eligible applicants will be scheduled for testing and interviews. Final selections will be made no later than March 2015.

- 1. Apply directly to UH Mānoa for the Fall 2015 semester.
 - Complete the UH System Admission Application online at: https://apply.hawaii.edu
 - Submit the Self-Reported Supplemental Application for first-time freshmen to UH Mānoa Office of Admissions.
 - Pay the \$70 application fee or request a fee waiver from your high school counselor if you qualified for a SAT/ACT fee waiver.

2. Apply to COP

Complete the COP 2015 Application online at www.hawaii.edu/cop.

Submit the COP 2015 Application Checklist with the following supporting documents to the COP office together in one packet:

- Official high school transcript. First quarter senior grades must be included.
- College transcripts, if applicable
- SAT and/or ACT scores
- Two (2) COP Recommendation Forms with one to be completed by a high school college preparatory class teacher and the other by a high school grade level or college/career counselor.
- Parent's/legal guardian's <u>2013</u> Federal Tax Return Transcript. To download a copy of your parent's/legal guardian's tax return transcript, go online to http://www.irs.gov/Individuals/Ordera-Transcript or call 1-800-908-9946.
- Signed Certification Form (Print and sign Certification Form after successful submittal of the COP 2015 Online Application.)

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the application checklist is complete and all supporting documents are submitted by the deadline date. The COP 2015 Checklist and COP Recommendation Forms are available at the COP website. COP will not accept any application, or part thereof, that is emailed or faxed. If any item is missing, the application will be deemed incomplete and not processed.
