E komo mai i Kamehameha! We are honored and privileged to continue to shape your child's academic, spiritual, physical, social and leadership development in an environment rich in heritage, spirituality, and Hawaiian culture.

Enclosed with this letter is an enrollment packet which includes the SY 2015-2016 Tuition Contract, Electronic Enrollment Instructions, and an Enrollment Checklist with Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs). All billing and collection activities for students enrolled in grades K – 12 will continue to be provided by FACTS Management. Unless otherwise selected, all accounts are automatically set up to be billed in monthly installments over an eight month payment plan.

Tuition for the SY 2015-2016 is summarized in the table below:

Kamehameha Schools is committed to the use of technology to support learning in and beyond the classroom and has invested in the technology and infrastructure for a one-to-one computing program. All students will be assigned an Apple laptop or iPad with a customized package of software to support the secure and robust integration of technology for students at every grade level. The equipment and technology maintenance costs associated with this program are included in next year's tuition.

Every student at Kamehameha Schools receives financial assistance through a subsidy that covers approximately 80 percent of total program costs. Although the cost of your child's K-12 tuition constitutes a small percentage of the overall cost per student, Kamehameha continues to offer financial aid to eligible families who need help paying this out-of-pocket cost. All families, even those who qualify for full financial aid, are required to pay a **\$100 reservation deposit** toward their child's enrollment for next year. This deposit will be added to your existing account and billed accordingly on 4/1/2015 by FACTS Management. Payment should **be received by FACTS no later than 4/30/2015**. A 1% finance charge will be assessed on all deposit payments received after 4/30/2015. Failure to pay this deposit by the stated due date may jeopardize your child's enrollment status.

All outstanding account balances with Kamehameha Schools for which you are responsible **must be current by 5/21/2015**. If *past due amounts* remain unpaid after 5/21/2015 and you have not sought assistance through your campus Fiscal Administrator, KS reserves the right to offer your child's seat to the next child on the waiting list.
