Fifth Grade

Building on the foundation of the "Fruit of the Spirit" from Galatians 5:22-23, students learn about the Holy Spirit (God the Spirit) and how we were created in the image of God. Through the use of songs, games, biblical, historical and contemporary role models; students are challenged to begin developing a Godly (Christ-like, Spirit-Filled) character.
