Things to Consider

- If you upload content to the site, will the site have perpetual ownership to the content uploaded?
- If they do have ownership rights, understand that they have the right to share your content with anyone and do anything with your content.
- Do your students meet the minimum age requirement to create an account on this site?
- By agreeing to the T&Cs, will the site have permission to share and/or sell your account information?

2. Seek Approval from Appropriate Parties



- Seek approval from your department head and principal's office. Be prepared to share how you will be using the site tied to your curriculum.
- Notify parents about the site and receive permission to have your students create a site account


3. Be Responsible

Do not post any Personally Identifiable Information Social Security Number or even the last 4 digits Birthdate, Address, Phone Number



Are you willing to take personal responsibility for anything you or your students post on this site?

Are you able to control or remove any inappropriate student postings?



Think Before You Post

If you feel angry or passionate, it's wise to delay posting until you are calm and clear headed.

Search engines can turn up posts and pictures years after the publication date Comments can be forwarded or copied

Archival systems save information even if you delete a post

4. Additional Help is On the Way
