Dress Guidelines



Students may wear the appropriate Aloha Wear attire. Aloha Wear attire <u>MUST BE</u> Aloha print.

Gentlemen

- Collared <u>aloha print</u> shirt with denim jeans, slacks or uniform / dress shorts and covered shoes
- No surf shorts
- No plaid or solid colored collared shirts
- No T-shirts
- No slippers

Ladies

- <u>Aloha print</u> tops (tank style tops or spaghetti straps <u>must</u> be worn with a sweater)
- Dress standards shorts and skirts allowed Please refer to the Student & Parent Handbook for guidelines on skirt and shorts measurements.
- Jeans allowed
- Knee length dresses
- Sandals with straps allowed, with heels no higher than 1-inch or covered shoes
- No halter tops, off the shoulder tops or strapless tops
- No slippers (rubber or dressy)
