

Colonialism and 13 Colonies Test Corrections

Aloha e nā haumāna,

This is how to make up test scores for partial credit:

1. Come to my room during break/s or after school. (I am available most breaks, and after school until 3:30 on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays Please make arrangements to be picked up at 3:30)
2. Bring your notes, resources, and your original test. You can use them all; you can also use a textbook.
3. Work by yourself.
4. For each question you correct, you must use binder paper to:
 - a. Number the question & write the correct answer (multiple choice/matching); OR
 - b. Draw the correct map (on a clean copy, provided by me); AND
 - c. Write a full-sentence explanation of why that is the correct answer. (You may not restate the answer or say the other options are wrong.)
 - d. Write in where you got the correct information.
5. For each answer that you get correct AND explain adequately, I will give ½ credit.
6. Correct answers with explanations that do not show understanding will not receive any credit.
7. It is possible to bring up your score by 2 letter grades, if you **do the work** well.
8. I will pass back tests on Wednesday, 1/18 (E) and Thursday, 1/19 (O).
9. Test corrections must be completed by Wednesday, 1/25, so that I can score and upload by Friday 1/27.
