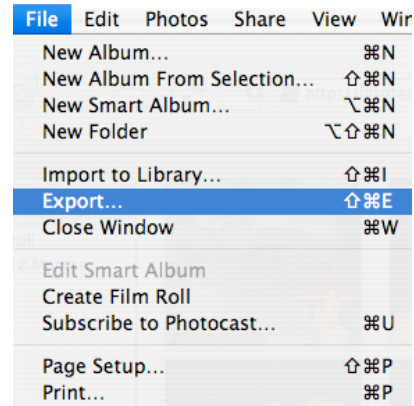
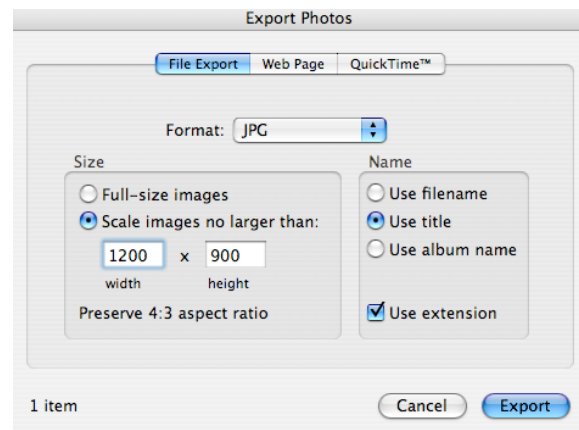


## Batch Resizing Images in iPhoto

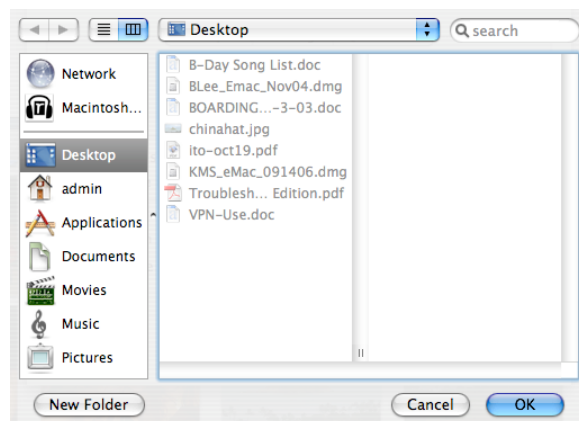
- 1) Open iPhoto.
- 2) Select or highlight a group of pictures (pictures should be of the same orientation, portrait/landscape).
  - a) **Shift + click** = Selects a range of pictures.
  - b) **Apple key + click** = Allows you to pick and choose which pictures to select.
- 3) Go to “File”→ “Export.”



- 4) The “Export Photos” window will appear.
- 5) Click on the “File Export” tab.
- 6) Select “JPG” as the format.
- 7) Click on “Scale images no larger than:”
  - a) Type in your preferred width and height (For your ksbe photo gallery, choose 1200 x 900).
- 8) Click on “Export” (bottom right hand corner).



- 9) Choose where to save your pictures.
  - a) It's a good idea to create a new folder for your photos. This new folder will appear on your desktop by default.
  - b) Click on “New Folder” in the bottom left hand corner.
  - c) Type in a name for the new folder, for example “Resized Photos”.



- 10) Click “OK.”
