



iPad Change Camera Settings on iPad to .JPG Photos

Overview: This help guide is to show how to change the Camera settings in the iPad so that photos are taken as .JPG files instead of .HEIC files.

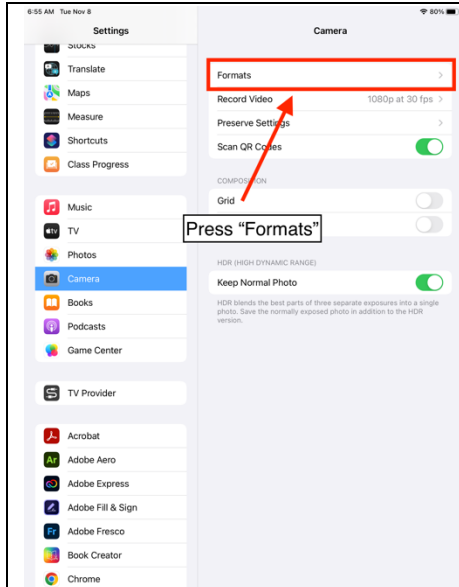
This will help with importing photos into Google Drive & Docs, MS Word, etc. It will also help when sharing across Mac and PC computers.

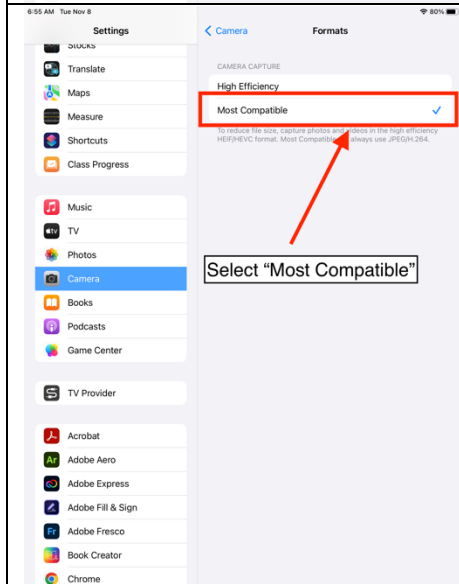
