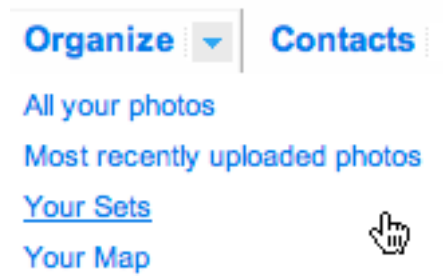

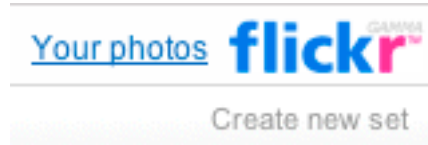

### 3. To upload pictures from KS Photogallery.

1. Navigate to the picture that you want to use. You may use the thumbnail or you may click on the photo to get the larger images. It is recommended that picture size should be ~480 pixels in longest dimension. Large pictures will take longer to load.
2. Right click (or ctrl and click) on the photo and select view image and copy the url using right click again.
3. Paste url into Placemark using ``.
