



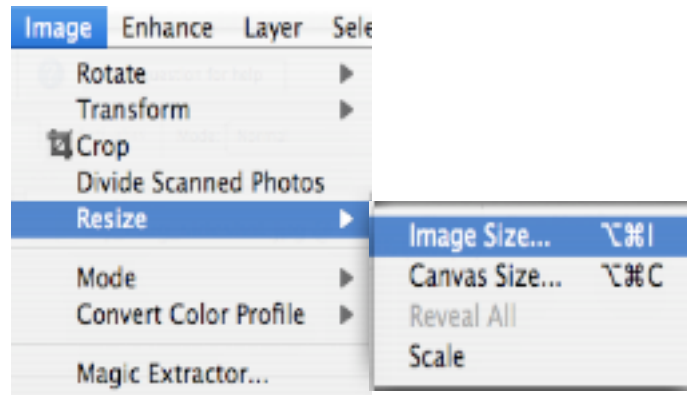
# Resizing an Image in Photoshop Elements

You can proportionately resize an image in Photoshop Elements by following these basic steps.

1. Open the file you wish to resize.



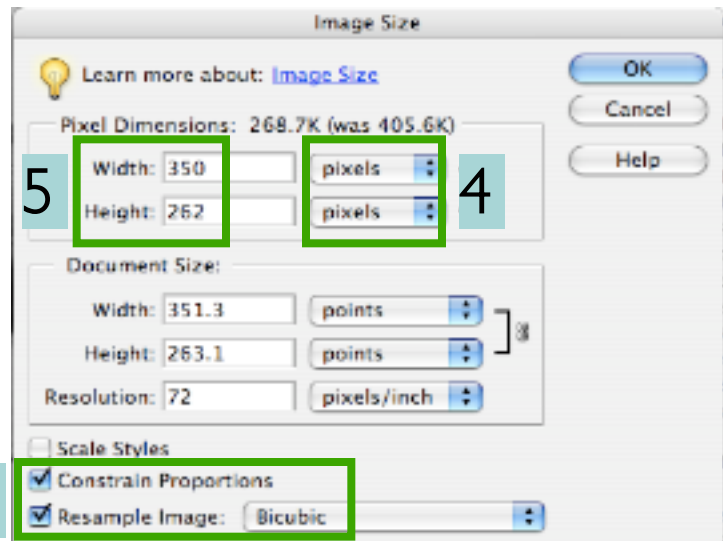
2. From the menu bar, select **Image > Resize > Image Size**.



3. The **Image Size** window will appear. Click on **Resample Image** and **Constrain Proportions**. (This will proportionately change the height when you enter a new value for the width and vice versa.)

4. To the right of the width/height, select the **unit of measurement** for resizing.

5. Type in the desired width or height, then click **OK**. The resized image will appear.



6. From the menu bar, select **File > Save As...** to save the newly sized image.

7. In the **Save As...** window, type in a unique name for the resized image so that it doesn't replace the original image. Click **Save**.
