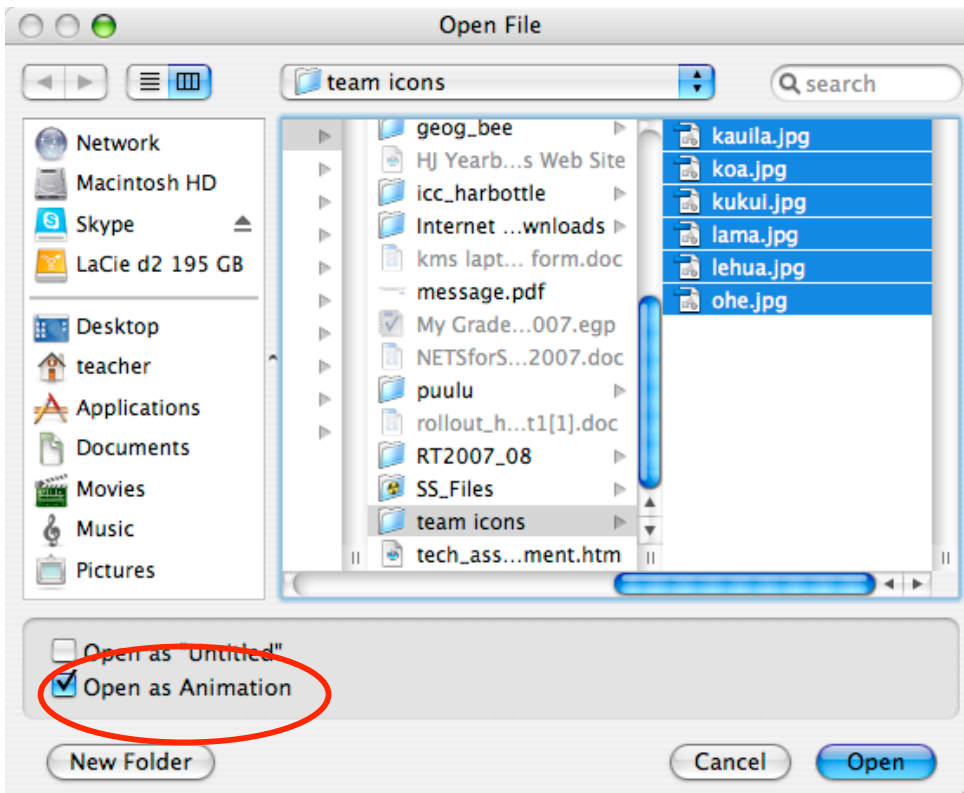
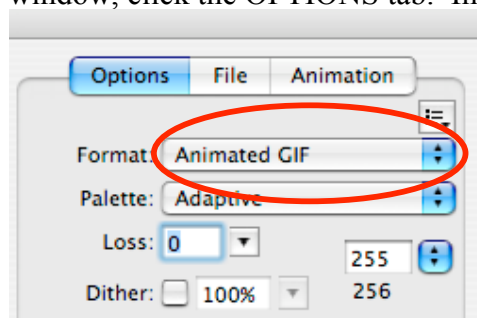


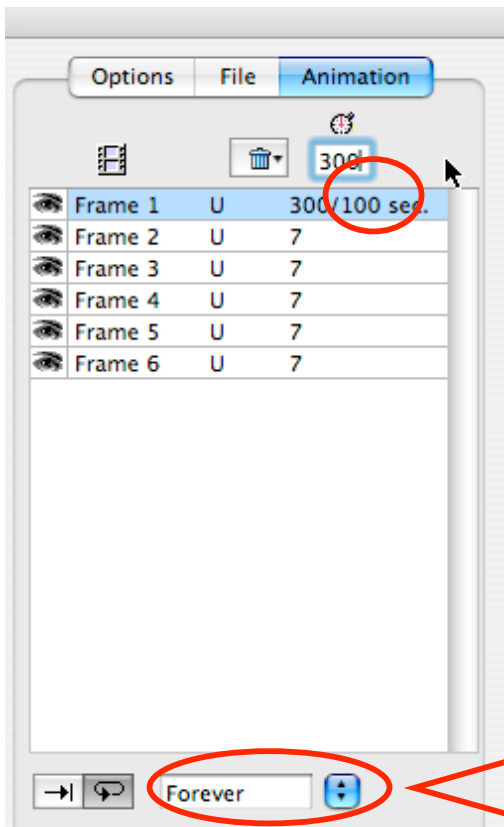
1. Be sure that the images you would like to use are the same size. You can use iPhoto or Photoshop Elements to do this.
2. Use the SHIFT key and click on all images to select all image files you'd like to use in your animated gif if they are in a list. Or press APPLE key and click on images files you'd like to use that are in a random order. Be sure that you check the box in front of "OPEN AS ANIMATION". Then click OPEN.



3. Then, in the FILE menu, click on IMAGE PREVIEW.
4. In the IMAGE PREVIEW window, click the OPTIONS tab. In the FORMAT menu, select ANIMATED GIF.

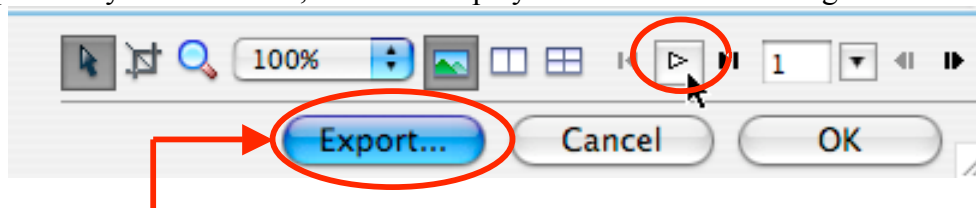


- In the ANIMATION tab, adjust the time of each frame. NOTE: 100 seconds is actually 1 second. If you would like an image to be displayed for 3 seconds, you should change the time to 300. The frame should then read 300/100. Repeat the process for each FRAME (image) in your animation.



If you would like for the images to constantly loop and display the animation, be sure FOREVER is selected.

- To preview your animation, click on the play button at the bottom right of the IMAGE PREVIEW window.



- Click on the EXPORT button and save picture to the desired location with your preferred name. The file should have the extension “.gif”
- Finally, insert your animated gif into your Dreamweaver. Click INSERT > IMAGE in the drop down menu and upload. Also upload the animated gif into your blog!
