

KA MO'OLELO O HĀLOA

Based on your understanding of the story of Hāloa shared & discussed in class, you must retell the mo'olelo.

KA HA'AWINA

The goal of this ha'awina is to retell the story using **only 4 scenes or sketches,** much like a storyboard. It is thru these sketches that you will illustrate your understanding and explanation of the story of Hāloa.

You will not be graded on your artistic capabilities (your ability to draw); however, you will be graded on the content of the story that you embed within your scenes or sketches. The more detail, the better!

The use of words, numbers, or symbols is prohibited. This includes symbols such as +,=, etc.

E 'olu'olu 'oe, please try to be less literal in your drawings. Stick figures and smiley faces are too literal. Instead, ask yourself what are objects that represent the characters in the mo'olelo.
