Who Needs 'Em?

PHYSICAL EXAMS - (NEW FORM!! KSM Student Health History & Physical Exam Form)

(MD must sign BOTH parent/student completed Student Health History and Physical Exam)

Who: All New Invitees and Returning Students to grades 3, 6, 9 & 11

When: Deadline: **Returning Students May 1, 2016**

New Invitees only June 1, 2016

What if I can't get an appointment? If completion of Physical can't be done by May 1st, parent must submit an official medical appointment slip with proof of appointment date by this date.

Who needs a TB test? *All New Invitees*

Immunizations: New invitees must provide official documentation of complete Immunization History.

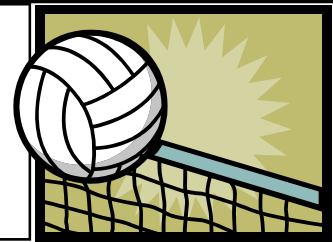
New Immunization Requirements for New Invitees and Returning 6th Graders: Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap); Human Papilloma Virus (HPV); and Meningococcal Vaccine (MCV). *(New Students 16 and older require 2nd Meningococcal Vaccine.)*

ATHLETIC PHYSICALS: NEW FORM!! Same form as for KSM school physicals. *(MD must sign BOTH parent/student completed Student Health History and Physical Exam)*

Who: Any middle or high school student participating in after-school or inter-scholastic sports.

When: Before sports participation. *(Not required to start school.)*

How long are they valid: 13 months from examination date.



Medical Treatment Agreement and Release & Student Health Summary

Who Needs Them?

- **Who:** EVERYONE!!!!!! **When:** Deadline May 1, 2016
- Medical Treatment Agreement and Release & Student Health Summary must be completed on KS Connect each year for every student. *(New students complete hard copy Student Health Summary.)*
- Both parents/legal guardians signatures are required.
If one parent has sole LEGAL custody, legal documentation must be submitted. (Parent who has sole Physical custody but shared LEGAL custody still needs both parent signatures.)
