

“Self in Social Studies” Summative Poster & Essay

1. Create a poster showing your ‘ohana, yourself, and the internal and GeoSHAPE forces that affect you.
 - a. Draw a large body outline showing something essential about YOU.
 - b. Choose pictures showing how each part of Social Studies (GeoSHAPE) affects you. Be specific.
Example: a picture of your home or car will tell more about your economics than a dollar sign.
 - i. Be sure to show the internal & external GeoSHAPE forces that affect you.
 - ii. Internal forces go inside, and external GeoSHAPE forces go outside the outline.
 - iii. Label each force.
2. Write a short essay explaining the personal meaning of each image you have selected for each category.
 - a. ½ to 1-page, 12 pt., Times New Roman, 1 inch margins. Essay Rubric coming soon.
